## City Council Corner

Hooray for a little rain and some Autumnal temperatures!

The council selected a roofing company to repair hail damage to the gymnasium, school building, ballpark stage, and concession stand roofs. We also chose a bond council to help with the process of using a low-interest, partially forgivable loan from the Arkansas Natural Resources Division. This will help fund more water system improvements. Meanwhile, the project to replace outdated water meters with new remote-read meters is 75% complete. Water Department crews continue to repair water line leaks on a daily basis. Mayor Jarnagan has been checking new master valves in the middle of the night when leakages can be more easily detected. City staff is working on setting up a new billing software for water system accounts.

The council will review construction estimates for building a paved trail around the ball field at Larry "Tiny" Jarnagan Park (a.k.a. Slicker Park). This 6 foot wide, 1/3 mile long loop paid for, in part, by a \$100,000 Arkansas Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism grant will provide exercise opportunities for our community and accessibility to amenities for people with disabilities.

The metal marker designating the Downtown Winslow Commercial Historic District has arrived. Stop by the Winslow Museum, read about our historic city, and enjoy the new museum exhibits.

Visit WinslowAR.com for more information about our city. Everyone is invited to Saturday morning Coffee Klatch gatherings at City Hall and the Farmers Market downtown from 8:30 to 11:30. Residents are also welcome to attend City Council meetings on third Mondays at 6 pm.

The Department bought a 4x4 engine pumper. We plan to use it as an engine/rescue unit out of station 1 or 3.

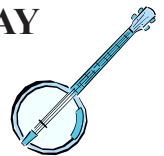
Get to know BMFD Personnel

# Welcome to the WINSLOW WATERWORKS (AR) Online Bill & Payment Portal!

An Easy & Convenient Way to View and Pay Your Bill Online

**GO PAPERLESS!! SIGN UP FOR ONLINE BILLING SERVICES AND HAVE INSTANT ACCESS TO YOUR ACCOUNT INFORMATION 24/7**

**To make a Winslow Waterworks bill payment (even if you have not registered):**

- Go to [winslowwater.viewmybill.net](http://winslowwater.viewmybill.net)
- Under the Unregistered Users heading, click where it says “Click Here to pay your bill.”
- This will take you to the SOFTtelPay payment system where you will enter your account number, payment amount, and credit card information.
- You can also call **855-483-5729** to make a payment, and use Winslow’s company code **7295911**.

**To register so you can view your next bills online:**

- Before you begin, make sure you have your current bill in hand because you must enter your name and account information exactly as it appears on the bill. (If any information is incorrect, you must contact your utility office through their preferred method.)
- To begin the registration process, go to [winslowwater.viewmybill.net](http://winslowwater.viewmybill.net) and click the “Register” link. You will need the following information from your bill: the last 8 digits of your account number, customer name, and service address.
- **When you register, please be aware that you will still have the option to receive a paper bill, but you must check the box to opt in. If you opt out of receiving a paper bill, you will still be able to print a copy from the website after you login.**
- *After you submit your registration, you will receive an email where you **must** click the link to activate your account.* At this point, you can login to your account. However, you will *not* see your bill until the utility company does your next billing.
- After the next billing, you will receive an email notifying you that your bill is ready to be viewed. Be sure to add the following 2 email addresses to your Address Book so the emails do not get blocked: [notifications@mail.viewmybill.net](mailto:notifications@mail.viewmybill.net) and [softtelpay@mail.viewmybill.net](mailto:softtelpay@mail.viewmybill.net)
- Once you have received your first bill, you can click the link and login with your email address and password to view your bill. If you wish, you can pay your bill from your account screen or from the Bulletin Board screen. (You will need the last 8 digits of your account number from your bill.)

**When you sign up for Online Billing Services you will receive a monthly email notification when your bill is ready for viewing. No more bills to file or shred!! Simply register for Online Billing Services and you will have instant access to your account information.**

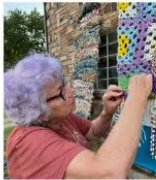

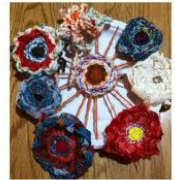

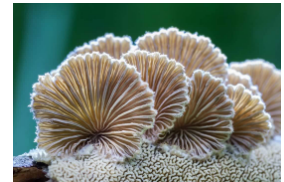
